ACCESS BY CAR OR ON FOOT WILL BE ALLOWED ONLY THROUGH GATE B:



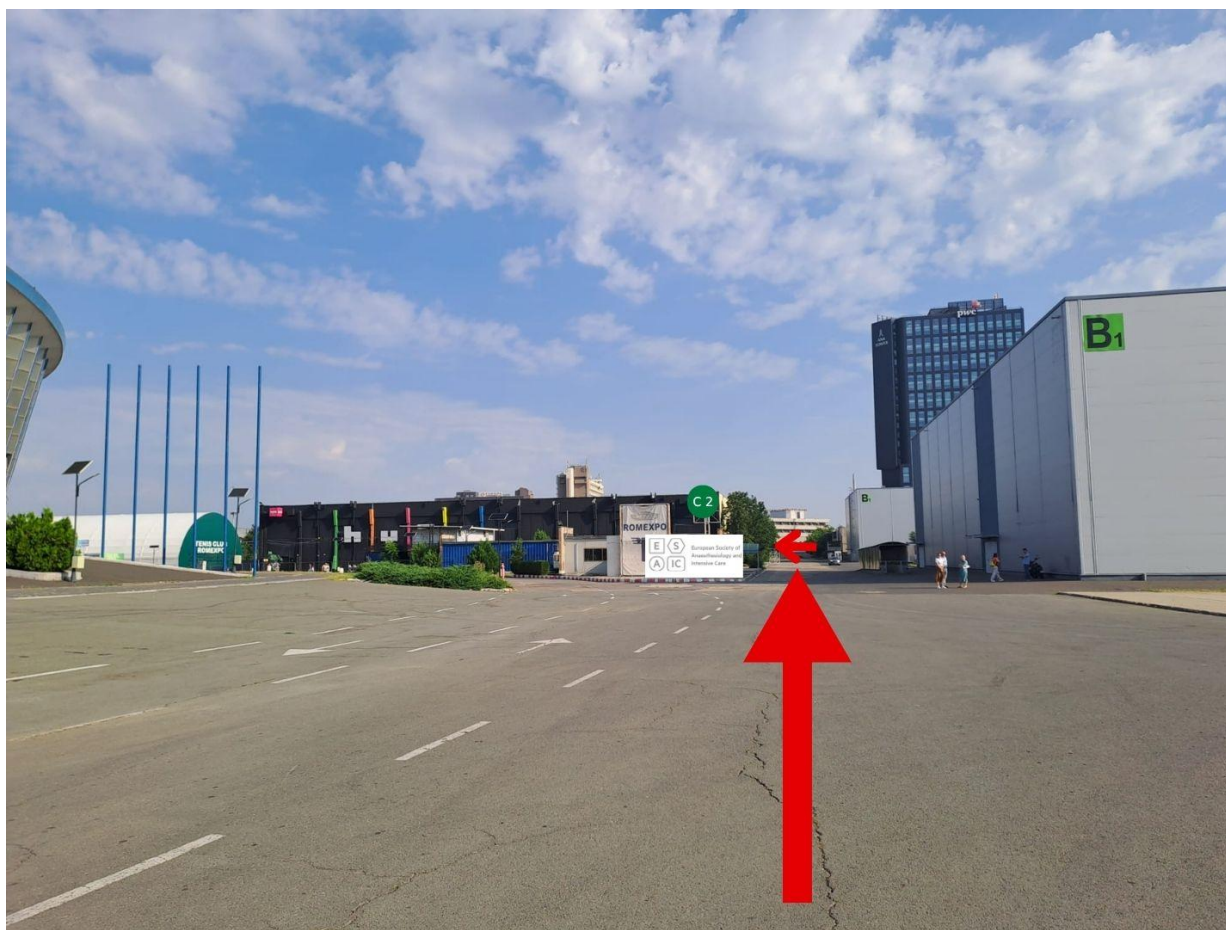
ENTRANCE VIA GATE B – FROM EXPOZIȚIEI BOULEVARD

By bus:

From Henri Coanda - Otopeni airport: Take Bus 783 or 780 to Piața Presei Station → walk to Expoziției Boulevard and enter through Gate B



From Gara de Nord train station: Take Bus 105 to Universitatea Româno-Americană Station → walk to Expoziției Boulevard and enter through Gate B

From Bucharest City Centre: Take Bus 361 to Piața Presei Station → walk to Expoziției Boulevard and enter through Gate B

By metro:

Option 1: Take M4 metro line to Străulești Station → Bus 105 to Universitatea Româno-Americană Station → walk to Expoziției Boulevard and enter through Gate B



Option 2: From the Militari or Titan Area >>> Take M3 metro line to Eroilor Station → M1 to Crângași Station → Tram 41 to Piața Presei Station → walk to Expoziției Boulevard and enter through Gate B

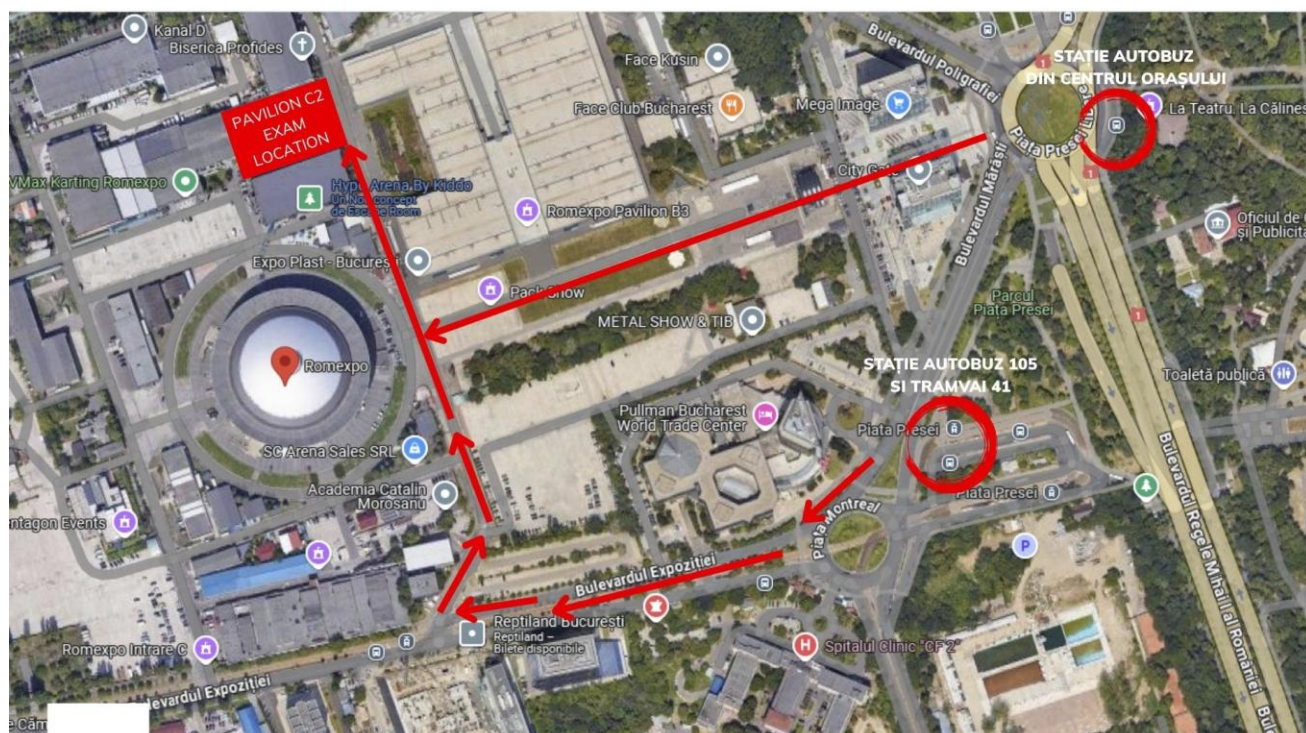
By car / taxi:



Drive to Expoziției Boulevard and find Gate B to access the ROMEXPO centre.

Parking is available at Romexpo (5 LEI/hour), across from Pavilion B3, subject to availability.
